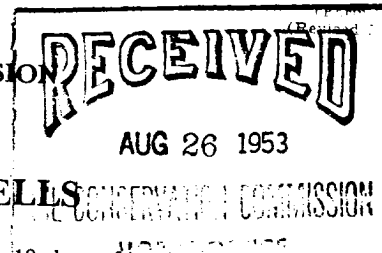

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD: 8735 FBTD 6740-Line

5 1/2" casing set at 8705'.

Cement and bridge plug at 6592' was drilled out and a C. I. drillable bridge plug was set at 6750' with 10' of cement dumped on top. Casing was perforated with 4 shots per foot as follows: 6582-6617, 6640-6648, and 6714-6724, and 6667-6688.

With a packer at 6537', formation was treated through perforations with 3000 gallons of 15% regular acid.

Well pumped 121 bbls. of oil in 24 hours on 8-22-53. GOR-541, Gas 65.6 MCF per day, Gravity 38.5.
