## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

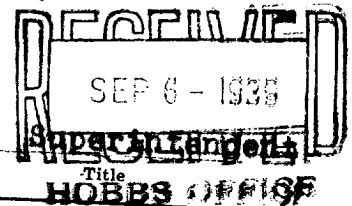
7" OD 8thd. 22# new casing was set at 3385' and cemented with 250 sacks Trinity Special Cement; allowed to set 72 hrs. and drilled plug. After allowing to stand 3 hrs. under 1000# pressure, hole was determined dry and drilling was resumed.
