Dear Mr. Culbertson:

We have today approved Form C-110, Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil, on your Martin "B" Well #2.

Upon checking the well file I find that you have not filed the Form C-102, Miscellaneous Notices, on any of the casing. In the future these reports must be filed before casing is tested. I refer you to Rule 26, Order 4, of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission which reads in part:

"Before any casing is tested, the owner shall file in triplicate with the Commission a notice of intention to test casing shut-off on Form C-102, "Miscellaneous Notices." The Commission will return to the owner a copy of the notice on which will be noted the Commission's approval, with any modifications considered proper, of the plan submitted, or its rejection."
