On February 4, 1974, we wrote you concerning your filing Form C-103 on your Langlie Jal Unit Well No. 25 located in Unit N of Section 32, T-24-S, R-37-E. Form C-103 was received in this office on February 8, 1974, wherein you stated that tubing and packer had been set in the well and water injection commenced into perforations from 3336 to 3491.

According to our records, this well had been producing from the interval 3470 to 3546, and on your Form C-103 there was no mention as to the disposition of the old production interval.

We are therefore returning Form C-103 for clarification as to the disposition of the old perforated interval.

If there is a log available for this well, please submit this so that we may properly classify this well as to either Jalmat or Langlie Mattix.
