## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After a 26 hour shut-in period, this well had a shut-in tubing pressure of 352 PSIA; as measured with a dead weight pressure gage. Based on a back pressure test conducted 7-25-51 which had an absolute open flow of 960 MCF per 24 hours, a shut-in tubing pressure of 356 PSIA, and a  $\theta$  of 58°, ( $\theta$  measured from horizontal); the calculated ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW IS 947 MCF PER 24 HOURS.
