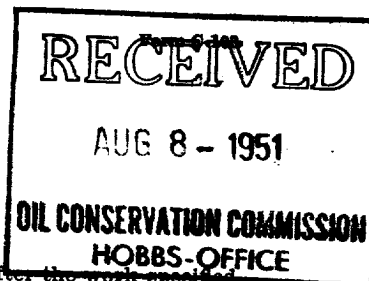

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After a 24 hour shut-in period a back pressure test was conducted using a dead weight pressure gage and 2" critical flow prover. Wellhead prover pressures were used for all volume and pressure calculations. The resulting ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW WAS 968 MCF PER 24 HOURS with a 58° slope back pressure curve as measured from the abscissa.
