Gentlemen:

Your Humble L State Well No. 3 located in Unit I of Section 32, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, is classified as a gas well in the Jalmat Gas Pool. However, the latest reports in our file for the well show it to be an open hole completion from 3427 to 3550 feet, which would indicate that it should properly be classified as a gas well in the Langlie Mattix Oil Pool. There is in our file a form dated December 30, 1941, submitted by Humble Oil & Refining Company, which indicates that the 7" casing was perforated from 3123 to 3177 feet, and there is no later information stating that these perforations were squeezed.

Please review your records for this well and submit Commission Form C-103 indicating exactly from what depth and formation this well is producing at the present time so that we may properly classify the well.
