In our "Notice of Intention to Drill" this well, filed with you on July 25, 1939, we reported that it would be drilled with cable tools. This has been changed, we are going to use rotary tools from top to total depth. This necessitates a change in the casing program, the following being the strings it is our intention to use:

9-5/8" OD 36# New Casing, set at approximately 1200' and cemented with 400 sx cement, Halliburton Process. The cement will be circulated to cellar.

7" OD 24# New Casing, set at approximately 3415' with about 200 sx cement, Halliburton Process.

The drilling contractor for this well is the Morter Drilling Company of Ardmore, Oklahoma.
