Following is a notice of intention to do certain work as described below at the Phillips Petroleum
Company's M. C. Woolworth Well No. 4 in R/2
Company or Operator Lease
of Sec. 35, T. 24S, R. 37E, N. M. P. M., Mattix Field,
Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We propose to dually complete the above well to produce oil and gas by setting Baker Production packer at 3270' and gun perforating 7" casing to permit production of gas from Sandy Lease in the Basal Rates at approximately 3000-3130' and produce oil from the present producing section at 3445-31' leaving an impervious section of 315' between the gas and oil zones. Considering our proposed method of dually completing this well based on experience of other completions of this nature, a separation of the above mentioned two zones will be obtained and maintained. We desire to use the gas from this well in gas lifting wells No. 1 to 8 inclusive on this lease. It will take approximately 15 MCF gas per well per day or a total of 3690 MCF gas per month for gas lift operations of the 8 wells on this lease. The gas returned from these wells will be taken by the El Paso Natural Gas Company, processed in their Jal Plant; residue will then be taken into their system for fuel and light purposes. It is anticipated by gas lift method of producing these wells based on experience on M. C. Woolworth No. 5 that an additional 43000 bbls. of oil will be recovered. Installation of conventional pumping equipment on these wells cannot be economically justified as cost of same will exceed value of anticipated additional recovery. The installation of gas lift equipment for the 8 wells will save 35 tons of critical equipment over the installation of conventional pumping equipment. A complete brief of this has been filed as of May 4, 1944. We wish to advise application for special exception PAO No. 11 covering this request has been granted and case No. C-1287 has been assigned by P.A.W.
