T. D. 3539 Line. Cleaned out to bottom. Placed 10' pea gravel on bottom. Dumped 185 qts S.N.G. at 3529. Ran 1-4 1/2 x 2 1/2' tin shell with 20 qts S.N.G. Set time bomb to detonate at 12:00 AM October 29, 1940. Tamped with pea gravel 3485 to 3395. Dumped 6 sacks Calseal, top 3358. Shot exploded on schedule. Cleaned out to 3526. Tubed with 2" to 3520 with perforation 3507 to 20. On 24 hour test, after recovering circulating oil, well flowed 41 bbls oil, no water, Gas-oil ratio 6113. Bottom Hole Pressure 420#.
