## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3541 Lime. SLM correction in T.D. Loaded hole with oil, put in gravel anchor from 3530' to 3541'. Ran in 280 qts. SNG from 3421' to 3530' and set one 24-hour AG double clock time bomb to detonate 3:00 PM March 1st. Tamped shot with 4 yards gravel from 3055' to 3421'. Shot exploded as per schedule. Went in with drill pipe and found top of gravel at 3077'. Cleaned out to bottom with drill pipe circulation oil. Well was then tubed with 2" tubing to 3508' and shut in to wait for pipe line connection in order to have tankage to test. March 31st tested 5 hours thru open 2" tubing. Flowed 331 bbls. oil, no water. Gas measured 1, 622 MCF daily. Gas-Oil ratio 1021.
