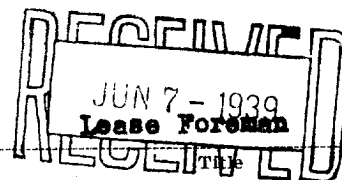

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3550 Lins. Loaded hole with oil & placed 300 qts. SNG from 3430' to 3550'.  
Shot exploded 11:00 AM May 27th, 1939. Found top of gravel tamp at 3006'.  
Cleaned out to bottom with rotary using oil as circulating fluid.  
After tubing to 3536' 8" with 2" the circulating oil was recovered and  
June 3rd the well was tested. On 6 hour test thru open 2" tubing well  
flowed 394 bbls. oil, no water. Gas measured 1,467 MCF daily. Gas-Oil  
ratio 932.
