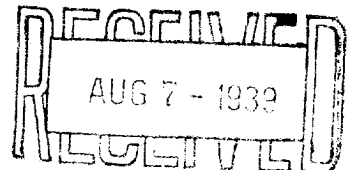

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 3565 Line. Placed 3' gravel anchor on bottom & ran 112 qts. SNG in 4 - 5" x 7-3/4' tin shells from 3562' to 3534'. Set time bomb to detonate 8:20 AM 23rd. Used 2 yards gravel tamp and loaded hole with 175 bbls. oil. Shot exploded on schedule. Measured up & found top of bridge at 3290'. Cleaned out with oil. Ran 150 Joints 2" USE tubing to 3546' 10". Well open 6-1/2 hours July 31st, flowed 304 bbls. Circulating oil and was shut in for tankage. August 2nd the well flowed 208 bbls. fresh oil in 6 hours. Gas measured 1,092 MCF daily. Gas-oil ratio 1315.
