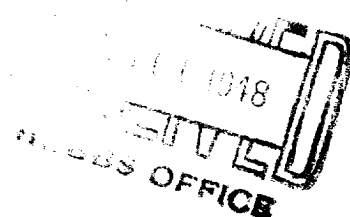

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cleaned out to old total depth of 3490'. Deepened to 3633' and encountered 1000' sulphur water. Plugged bottom of hole with lead wool and plugged back to 3587' with calseal - water shut off. Filled with gravel to 3565' and shot with 210 qts. nitroglycerin from 3440' to 3565'. Cleaned out after shot to 3550', reran tubing and placed on production.

Production increased by workover from 2 bbls. to 12 bbls. per day.
