REPORT OF THE BOARD OF PRISONS

The Board of Prisons, created by the Prison Reform Act of 1933, has the honor to submit herewith its report for the year ending June 30, 1934. The Board was organized on July 1, 1933, and has since that time been actively engaged in the study and reform of the prison system of the United States. Its first report, submitted in 1933, dealt with the general principles of prison reform and the need for a national system of prisons. This report, like the present one, is a preliminary report and is subject to change as the Board continues its study and makes recommendations.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BOARD

1. The prison system should be organized on a national basis, with a central authority and a system of regional prisons.
