The following work on subject well has been completed:

1. Perforate 2 7/8" casing w/1 JSPF from 6924'-6934', 6938'-6942', 6985' - 6994' and 7006' - 7038'.
2. Acidized perforations w/8000 gals 15% HCl acid in 12 equal stages w/25# flaked benzoic acid between 1st 6 stages, 50# benzoic acid between next 3 stages and 75# benzoic acid between last 3 stages. All blocks were mixed in gelled lease crude.
3. Swab and return to production.
4. Flowed on 24 hr test ending 11:00 AM, 7-19-71. F/178 bbls oil and 6 bbls water, Grav 39, GOR 1380, 22/64" choke, CP 175#.

Instructions
