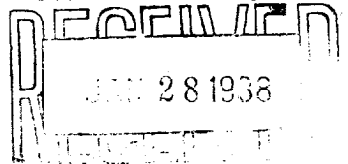

The work of the office has been divided into three main branches: the Surveying Branch, the Land Management Branch, and the Land Sales Branch. The Surveying Branch has been engaged in the surveying of public lands, the establishment of boundaries, and the measurement of areas. The Land Management Branch has been engaged in the management of public lands, the preservation of forests, and the regulation of mining. The Land Sales Branch has been engaged in the sale of public lands, the leasing of lands, and the collection of taxes.
