The following work on subject well has been completed:

1. Pull triple completion equipment.
2. Ran tubing w/packer and retrievable bridge plug. Located hole in casing 4854'-4885'. Set retrievable bridge plug @5116'. Dumped 10' sand on top bridge plug. Set packer @ 4732'. Test casing w/800#. Tested OK.
3. Squeeze casing leak w/80 sx Class 'C' cement. Pulled tubing & packer. Drilled out cement from 4739' - 4875'. Tested casing w/100# for 30 minutes. Tstd OK. Circulated sand off top of bridge plug @5116'. Retrieve bridge plug. Ran CIBP, and stopped @6021'. Drilled out bridges @6021' and 6064'. Cleaned out to 7761'.
4. Set CIBP @7746' PBD. Perforated 7" casing w/1 JSFF from 6742-78', 6800-06', 6815-30' and 6892'-6914'.
5. Set Model A-2 packer at 6607'.
6. Acidized perforations 6742-6914' w/6000 gals 15% NE acid in 15 - 400 gal stages w/5 ball sealers between stages.
7. Set Model K packer @5872'.
8. Swab and place on production.
9. On 24 hr OPT ending 3:00 PM, October 28, 1971. Flowed 20 bbls oil and 8 bbls water. Grav 62°, COR 32,500, 18/64" choke, TP 600#.
