Perforate 2-7/8" Blinebry casing w/1 JSPI from 5043-48', 5057-61', 1 JSPI at 5064', 65', 66', 70' and 72', 1 JSPF from 5077-82', 1 JSPI at 5085', 87', 5103', 05', 1 JSPF from 5113-22', 1 JSPI at 5142', 44', 1 JSPF from 5154-60', 1 JSPI at 5166', 1 JSPF from 5194-5200', 1 JSPI at 5206', 03', 12' and 5214'.
2. Run a Base Temperature Log.
3. Frac down 2-7/8" casing w/25,000 gals gelled lease crude w/25 lbs/1000 Gals MK II Adomite, 40 lbs/1000 Gals. gelling agent & 1 ppg 20/40 sand in 5 equal stages.
4. Swab, test and place on production.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
