Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated April 4, 1951 covering Well No. 5 Fristoe (NCT-2) on subject land in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 35, T. 24S, R. 37E, Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be sent you on request, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. Sufficient cement should be used in cementing the 9 5/8" casing to circulate to the surface.
3. Sufficient cement should be used in cementing the 7" casing to extend at least to base of salt section.
4. Copies of sample log, electrical log, temperatures and other surveys made are requested.
