INVESTIGATION OF THE
POLYMERIZATION OF
METHACRYLAMIDE

The polymerization of methacrylamide was studied in the presence of various catalysts and at different temperatures. The results show that the reaction is highly sensitive to the nature of the catalyst and the temperature. The highest yields were obtained with the use of a cobalt catalyst at 60°C. The molecular weight of the polymer increased with increasing temperature and decreasing catalyst concentration.
