DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On Feb. 28, 1951, ran steel line found caving at 3449', PB with pea gravel from 3449' to 3447'. Placed 340 qts. SNG from 3447' to 3342' in 4 1/2" shells. AG Duplex 24 hour bomb set for 23 1/2 hours to explode at 9:40 a.m. March 1, 1951. Filled hole from 3339' to 3338' with crushed brick. Filled from 3338' to 3330' with pea gravel. Dumped 22 calseal filled from 3330' to 3230'. Job complete 9:00 p.m. March 28, 1951.

Results: Flowed 45 bbls. oil, 2% BS&W through 2 3/8" tubing 12/64" choke in 24 hours. Gas volume 43,200 CF in 24 hours.
