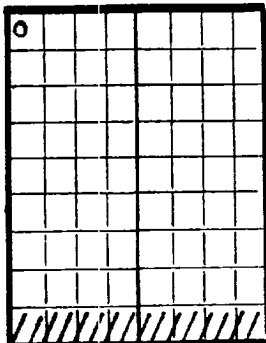

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 3150 feet.

Additional information: 10 3/4" & 8 5/8" casing will be pulled. A 7" OD Halliburton OV Multiple stage cementing tool will be set in the Rustler Anhydrite at approximately 1150'. Approximately 500 sacks cement will be used on first stage and 250 sacks cement on second stage.
