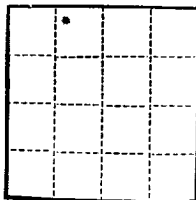

1. Operator proposes to re-enter hole and drill plugs and deepen well to approximately 8800' to test Ellenburger.
2. In the event of production, run 5-1/2" 15.5# and 17# J-55 and N-80 csg. and cement with approximately 800 sx.

Plats were previously furnished by Williamson Petroleum Company.
