This well is completed in the Blinebry, Fusselman and Montoya oil zones with the Blinebry zone presently temporarily abandoned. We propose to set a Baker Model "D" Packer with Baker Model "B" Packer Plug at 7065' to isolate and temporarily abandon the Montoya zone. A Brown type BP4H or Baker Lok-Set Packer will be set at 6970' to isolate the Fusselman and Blinebry Zones. The well will then be equipped to produce from the Blinebry and Fusselman oil zones through parallel strings of tubing. Blinebry zone in this well will produce from existing perforations 5434' - 5510'.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
