Re: Application to Dually Complete Cities
Service Oil Company's Hodges "B" No.1,
Justis Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

By means of this application Cities Service Oil Company wishes to state the following:

1. That Cities Service Oil Company's Hodges "B" No. 1 is located 660' North of the South line and 660' East of the West line of Section 1-T25S-R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. That it was completed in the Glorieta (Paddock) formation on October 11, 1946, at a total depth of 4823' with 7" casing cemented at 4747' and is currently producing as a gas well.
2. That attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of said well and the surrounding wells and lease holders.
3. That applicant now desires to dually complete captioned well so as to produce gas from the Glorieta (Paddock) formation through the tubing and gas from the Queen-Penrose through the casing tubing annulus in the following manner:
Justis Gas Pool
Queen-Penrose Pool
 - a. Perforate the 7" casing approximately 3102 to 3304 opposite the Queen-Penrose gas zone.
 - b. Set a production type packer below these perforations at approximately 4500'.
4. That the manner and method of dually completing, which is shown in the attached diagrammatic sketch marked Exhibit "B", is mechanically feasible and will prevent co-mingling of fluids and gases from the two reservoirs.
5. That copies of this application have been sent to operators of all leases directly or diagonally offsetting the said Hodges "B" Lease of the applicant as required by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 112-A for Dual Completions.

It is therefore respectfully requested that the Conservation Commission grant the applicant permission to dually complete this well in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Commission.
