

Gentlemen:

Commission Order No. R-2227, dated May 3, 1962 granted Amerada Petroleum Corporation permission to complete its State NJ "A" No. 3 in the Blinbry, Drinkard and Devonian Pools of the North Justis Field and to dispose of salt water into the San Andres formation. During operations subsequent to issuance of the order referred to above, the Drinkard Zone was found to be non commercial and the Devonian casing was junked slightly above the pay. The well has now been completed in the Justis Gas Pool, North Justis Blinbry and North Justis Fusselman Oil Pools and in the San Andres as a salt water disposal well.

Copies of Commission's Multiple Completion Form, schematic diagram of installation and plat of area are attached. Copies of the electric log were furnished with the prior application, however, additional copies will be supplied if necessary.
