## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

For the last two or three months we have been able to get our allowable out for the Humphrey lease on account of the fact that Shell's line will not carry the oil out -- they having a 4" line. Shell has agreed for us to set a pump at the tank battery for wells 1-2-3-4, and we wish permission to flow wells Nos 5 and 6 into this same battery instead of into the battery constructed for these two wells as indicated, so that the pump we have set at the battery for 1-2-3-4 will accommodate wells Nos. 5 & 6 the same as the others. We assume that this arrangement will be temporary, in as much as Shell contemplate laying a 6" line for their gathering system instead of the 4" line now used, which will not carry the oil from this locality because it does not have the capacity.

We will simply lay a flow line from wells Nos 5 and 6 to the battery in the north part of the lease where we have set the pump.

This is all one basic lease -- the royalty owners and also the Working interest owners are the same under all wells.
