Shot well with 280 quarts of nitroglycerine from 3348' to 3476', on 12-22-37. Shot was tamped with 15 feet of gravel.

Before the shot the well swabbed at the rate of 5 bbls. oil per hour but would not flow steady. After shooting and cleaning out to bottom the well flowed 159 bbls. of pipe line oil in 7 hours thru 7/8" choke with gas-oil ratio of 1020.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
