DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was killed with 25 tons of clay with Haliburton equipment and hole was bridged 3510 and stone driven in, filling up hole to 3485'. Steel cuttings and lead wool were driven in filling hole to 3475', then lead wool to 3470'. Pumped 30' of cement and let stand for 11 days at end of which time hole was dry. The well was then filled to top with cuttings from bit.
