Dear Mr. Mankin:

This letter is to clarify the status of R. Olsen's wells Nos. 2, 3, and 5, located in Section 5 T25S R37E.

Well No. 2- This well is being carried incorrectly at present in the proration schedule. The schedule shows this well to be in the Langlie-Mattix, but it is definitely a Jalmat well. Our Form C-110 on this well is correct.

Well No. 3-On this well there is no conflict, the proration schedule and Form C-110 are correct.

Well No. 5- This well is definitely in the Jalmat Pool. The proration schedule for December is correct, but our C-110 is incorrect. We need a new C-110 reclassifying this well from the Langlie-Mattix to the Jalmat Pool. When checking this well by logs last month, it was found to be miss-classified.
