With reference to our telephone conversation of this morning, we have checked our file on the Wells No. 4 in Unit F of Sec. 5 T25S R37E, and we find that this well is still carried on our records as a Langlie-Mattix oil well under the ownership of R. Olsen. The last forms filed by R. Olsen on this well show it to be producing from the Queen formation, and these forms were approved for a Langlie-Mattix oil allowable on April 17, 1956.

Since we do not have a record of the work that was done on this well to re-complete it as a Jalmat well, we shall appreciate it if you will bring the file up to date, in addition to filing Form C-110 denoting the change of ownership. If you have a copy of the Federal Form 9-331a showing this work, this will be satisfactory; however, Form C-104 must be filed also before an allowable can be assigned this well in the Jalmat Pool.
