DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill to the approximate depth of 3300', set 3.0' of 8 5/8" casing (surface) cemented with 250 sacks cement to set 24 hrs. Approximately 3300' of 5 1/2" casing to be set using 300 sacks neat cement, 2-staged at 1100' to set 48 hrs.
