FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

T.D. 3522'; 7" casing set at 3040'; formation packer set at 3362'.

This well is at present producing thru 2½" tubing from below the packer, daily average of 2.32 barrels oil, 20.8 barrels water and 2.5 MCF gas. This gas is being collected by the El Paso Natural Gas Company in their low pressure line.

On a 1½ hour test made thru 2" wide open from the annular space, this well produced 3,083 MCF gas corrected; pressure before test 1100#, after test 600# shut in. Small amount of oil in gas. The well flowed thru the tubing throughout this test.

We propose to set a high pressure separator and produce gas from the annular space, (in addition to normal production from below the packer), for sale to the El Paso Natural Gas Company's high pressure line.
