Our Harrison #1 located in Section 7, Twp. 25, Rge. 37, in Lea County, New Mexico was drilled in 1937 to a total depth of 3558. Seven inch casing is set at 3353. After numerous unsuccessful tests, the well was plugged back to 3300'. The well was perforated from 2870-2910 and completed as a gas well in the Yates.

This well has been carried as a gas well in an oil pool in the Cooper-Jal pool. We would like to have it changed to a gas well in the Jalnat pool. The top of the Yates is 2850' and top of Queens is 3350'.
