Gentlemen:

On August 26th, 1951, our E. C. Winters B-2, located 1980' from the south line and 660' from west line of Section 7, T25S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed as an oil well.

On December 8th, 1954, the above captioned well was recompleted as a dry gas well. This recompletion was accomplished by the installation of a high pressure separator and El Paso Natural Gas Company has their connection on this high pressure separator, permitting the dry gas produced from the Winters B-2 to be metered separately from any casinghead gas being produced from the E. C. Winters B-1.

Your records indicate the last GOR test was 173,029-1 such test dated March 27th, 1954. For your records and information a GOR test was run on October 13th, 1954 and the GOR at that time was 281,143 to 1.

We respectfully request you consider the information herein, including the attached C-104's and pass such information along to Mr. W. B. Macey who, by letter to us of January 26th, 1955, indicated the records still classified the Winters B-2 as an oil well and therefore was unable to grant a gas allowable.
