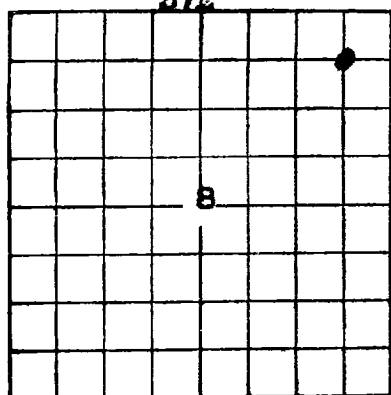

HISTORY OF OIL OR GAS WELL

It is of the greatest importance to have a complete history of the well. Please state in detail the dates of redrilling, together with the reasons for the work and its results. If there were any changes made in the casing, state fully, and if any casing was "sidetracked" or left in the well, give its size and location. If the well has been dynamited, give date, size, position, and number of shots. If plugs or bridges were put in to test for water, state kind of material used, position, and results of pumping or bailing.

Drill rig set from 1900' to 1905', showed a very small show of gas after setting 15 min. Drill shot from 1905' to 2300', showed gas after setting 15 min. After making drill stem test, the drilling fluid was blown out with gas and at the end of a 3 hour test the well was flowing 4000 bbls with no trace of oil. The well was tested by dynamiting, drilling all the way to 2300'. A 3 hour test showed neither gas nor oil at a depth.
