
Dear Mr. Montgomery:

In reference to your letter of June 20, advising us that it will be necessary to apply for a non-standard gas proration unit for our Woolworth No. 5-M, Section 8, 25S, 37E, Jalmat Pool, due to gas-oil ratio being in excess of 100,000 to 1, we would prefer to work the well over to attempt to lower the gas-oil ratio rather than to classify the well as a gas well.

If this work cannot be done before September 1, the well will be shut in pending workover. Zero allowable is requested on Form C-127 to be effective September 1.
