Enclosed please find Forms C-104, C-128 and C-110 on your Prichard Well No. 1-A SW NE Section 9, T-25-S, R-37-E, Jalmat Pool. You will note that these forms have been returned unapproved. The reason being that Form C-104 indicates that this well has a gas oil ratio of 32,000 to 1 which is an oil well although no oil well potential is given. Further, that the C-128 dedicates 160 acres whereas the spacing for an oil well is 40 acres, and the C-110 indicates Shell Pipeline as the transporter although I understand that perhaps McWood Corp. will be the transporter.

Enclosed please find Form C-104, "Oil and Gas Lease on Your Property," and Form C-105, "Leasehold Interest in Oil and Gas Property." You will note that these forms have been reviewed and approved. The reason being that Form C-104 is a standard lease form which has a lease of 10,000 to 15,000 acres of oil and gas, and the C-105 is a standard form for a lease of 40 acres or less. Although no oil well potential is given, Form C-104, that the C-105 indicates 100 acres, these are the actual acreage and the 40 acres, and the C-105 indicates 100 acres as the actual acreage. I understand that perhaps a good crop will be the transporter.
