Our Lease Superintendent has now advised us the pipe line gauger questions this designation because of the fact that run tickets have been and should continue to be made out in the name of Culbertson & Irwin, Inc. and R. K. Stovall, the joint lease owners, and the gauger states that he cannot make out the run ticket in that form because of the fact that Mr. Stovall's name was not shown on the C-110.

We believe that the gauger is wrong regarding this technicality for we notice that the C-110 on well No. 1-A on the same lease also shows our Corporation as Operator and no question has previously been raised concerning that well. We wish to handle this in the easiest way possible and are sending a copy of this letter to Shell Fipe Line Company, at Hobbs, with the request that if they can do so, they notify the gauger that he may continue to make the run tickets for all wells on the Stuart lease in the name of Culbertson & Trwin, Inc. and R. K. Stovall. If it is necessary or advisable to do so, we will be glad to prepare new Forms C-110 to show both names.
