Sandy lime 3415' - 3430'.

Grey lime 3430' - 3460'.

No apparent increase in natural production. Shot from 3335' to 3431 with 135 qts. glycerin. Preliminary tests indicate production increased from former rate of 19 bbls. per day to approximately 50 bbls. per day.
