FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Authority is requested to place seven wells on our J. A. Stuart lease, located in NE/4 & E/2 of NW/4 Section 10-25S-37E, and NW/4 of NW/4 Section 11-25-37, in a central tank battery. At the present time there are 6 producing wells on this property, all producing into a centralized battery of five 16' x 10' stock tanks. Authority for producing the sixth well into the common battery was obtained from Oil Conservation Commission on January 6, 1939.

Well #7 is now drilling which will be the last well on the property. By producing it into the centralized battery along with the six other wells, it will not be necessary to erect additional tankage to provide an additional, or separate, battery for this one well.

We have at the present time sufficient facilities and storage to take care of any testing which is to be done for each well. Separators and headers are so located that these tests may be made. All wells are located on the same basic property.
