

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has 9-5/8" casing cemented at 1100' and 7" casing cemented at 3250'.

Production has dropped to 18 bbls. oil per day and inasmuch as the hole has never been shot we propose to shoot it with 300 quarts (15-5 1/2" shells) solid Nitro Glycerin from 3345 to 3419'. We should be ready to shoot about Sept. 25, 1946.
