Comes now Applicant, THREE STATES NATURAL GAS COMPANY, by its Attorney and states:

1. It is the owner and operator of the Francis S. B. Stuart #1 well located in the SW/4 SW/4 (990' North of the South line and 990' East of the West line) of Section 10, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. Its Francis S. B. Stuart #1 well is completed within the vertical limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool and is capable of production of gas from a producing formation now defined by the Commission as within the Jalmat Gas Pool.
3. Its Francis S. B. Stuart #1 well is situated upon fee lands and Three States Natural Gas Company is the sole owner of the operating interest in these lands.
4. Its Stuart lease is offset by producing gas wells in the Jalmat Gas Pool and the entire lease is capable of production.
5. A plat of the above described land, the location of the subject well and all offset properties indicating well locations and lease ownership to the best of our knowledge is hereby attached and marked Exhibit "A".

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests, in the interest of conservation and protection of correlative rights, the Secretary of the Commission pursuant to the authority vested in him by Rule No. 5(b) of Commission Order R-520 grant administrative approval of the following non-standard proration unit without notice and hearing.
