Dear Mr. Surrett:

I am returning herewith form C-102, "Notice of Intention to Test Casing Shut-off" for the $8\frac{1}{4}$ " casing on your Francis Stuart Well No. 1 in Sec. 10, T. 25 S., R. 37 E., for correction.

The form C-101, "Notice of Intention to Drill" for the abovementioned well which I approved April 27, 1936, called for the following casing program: $15\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set @ 15' into the red beds and cemented with 300 sacks; the 9 5/8" casing set at 2500' and comented with 500 sacks (2 stage job); and the 7" casing set at 3100' and cemented with 500 sacks (2 stage job).

According to my records no surface pipe was set. In order to protect the surface waters, the regulations for this area call for the string which is set on top of the salt to be cemented with 150% of the calculated amount to bring it to the surface. According to form C-102, this string was set with only 75 sacks of cement, which may be a typographical error.

Your prompt attention in taking care of this matter will be greatly appreciated.
