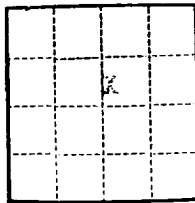

### DETAILS OF WORK

It is proposed to re-enter a plugged well, clean out to total depth 3430', and drill to 4300' (Tubb Brinkard). If productive, well will be dually completed in Minnerly and Tubb Brinkard. When this well was originally drilled in May 1961, 4 1/2" 24 J-35 casing was set and cemented to the surface. This casing was new. A 7 7/8" hole will be drilled to 4300' and if productive, new 5 1/2" casing of weights and grades for maximum protection will be set at total depth and cemented to the surface.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
