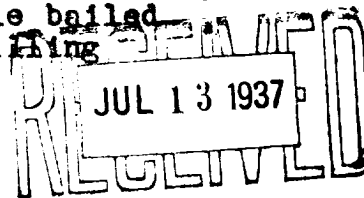

#### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was spudded on July 4, 1937. On July 5, 224' of 8-1/4", 32# pipe was run with 150 sacks of cement. Heavy mud was circulated before cementing and cement returns came to the cellar, entirely filling the hole. Pressure was put on the pipe and the pipe capped, and stood for thirty-six hours. Plug was drilled and hole bailed dry for water shut-off and found to be satisfactory. Drilling continued.
