It is proposed to drill this well to an approximate total depth of 3450' and test the Queens Sand. Casing program as follows:


Set 3 5/8" OD Casing @ 325' - Circulate Cement

Set @ top of salt. Cement with 200 sbs cement on 1st stage, and 150 sbs on 2nd stage.
