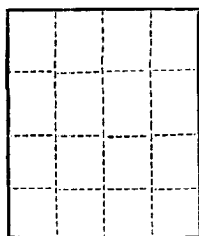

This well presently pumps from the Fusselman through perforations at 6996' to 7017'.

We propose to dual complete in the Brinkard by running 2 parallel strings of tubing and setting a permanent production packer at approximately 6800' to provide separation of the two zones. The Brinkard will be perforated from 5944 to 5990' and a dual packer set at approximately 5900'.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
