Re: Application for Approval of Dual
Completion, Gulf Oil Corporation's
Learcy McBuffington No. 7 in Justis-
Drinkard and Justis-Fusselman Pools,
Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, Gulf Oil Corporation wishes to state the following:

(a) That Gulf Oil Corporation's Learcy McBuffington No. 7, located 660' FSL and 990' FWL of Section 13-25S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed on June 9, 1958 at a plugged back total depth of 8490'. The attached plat shows the location of this well on the Gulf Oil Corporation's Learcy McBuffington Lease together with the location of all offset wells. The attached diagrammatic sketch shows the mechanical installation of the dual completion.

(b) That subject well has 7" casing set at 8518' and cemented with 758 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well producing from perforations within the interval 6924'-7014' from the Fusselman formation in the Justis-Fusselman Pool.

(c) That the applicant requests approval of the dual completion which is completed in the following manner:

- (1) The 7" casing is perforated from 5925' to 5950' in the Drinkard formation in the Justis-Drinkard Oil Pool.
- (2) A permanent type production packer is set at 6840'.
- (3) The Drinkard tubing is 2-3/8" OD tubing set at 5950' and the Fusselman tubing is 2-7/8" and 2-3/8" OD set at 7014'.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as an oil-oil dual completion from the Drinkard and Fusselman zones is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(f) That the manner and method of the dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

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
